RDI celebrated its Foundation Day on 20th and 21st in September. Flying Birds children also participated in the cultural programs on 21 September and presented their performance in the event.






MID-DAY MEAL AND REFRESHMENTS

The health checkup camp was scheduled for 29th September, the last Saturday of the month, but observing the several cases of fever and seasonal diseases in the basti, it was preponed on 24th September. Total 13 children, 4 boys and 9 girls were examined during the camp. 4 Children were found having fever, 2 each cold and cough and ENT problem and 1 skin related issues.

18 Parents also sought consultation from the doctor. 6 Parents were suffering from fever, 7 joints pain and 2 each with abdomen pain and toothache.
